From the summer of 2010 it is possible to inquire online and for free those Burgundian charters which have been gathered and included in the CBMA database (<http://www.artehis-cbma.eu>). This database is the only extended diplomatic corpus which allows the research of inter-documentary co-occurrences, advanced keyword search, as well as queries by chronological distribution and frequency, among others. These tools incite new ways of reading the documents as well as the comparison of literacy practices and of their dissemination; they may also incite the study of semantic fields. Moreover they demand the use of methods especially adapted for handling broad documentary masses.

The present symposium will deal with the revisiting of several research experiences using this database, ranging from punctual experiments to fully-developed academic works. The objective of this gathering is to invite researchers to become familiar with this interface and to assess it. All researches who desire to share their experiences are welcome to make a presentation.
